

## **Anne Marie Rafferty CBE**

Anne Marie Rafferty is **President of the Royal College of Nursing, Professor of Health Policy, former Dean** of the Florence Nightingale Faculty of Nursing and Midwifery, King's College London

She is a historian, health workforce and policy expert, graduated from Edinburgh University in Nursing Studies, MPhil (Surgery) Nottingham University, first nurse to gain a doctorate (DPhil Modern History) from Oxford University.

She was seconded to the Department of Health to work with Lord Ara Darzi on the **Next Stage Review of the NHS** and awarded a **CBE for services to healthcare** in 2008. She served on the **Prime Minister's Commission on the Future of Nursing and Midwifery 2009-10** and been recipient of various awards; **Nursing Times Leadership Award in 2014** and **Health Services Journal Top 100 Clinical Leaders Award in 2016** and **nominated one of the 70 most influential nurses in the 70 year history of the NHS.**

She holds fellowships from the **Royal College of Nursing, American Academy of Nursing** and one of the first nurses to be elected to the **Academy of Medical Sciences.**

She co-led a **Student Commission on the Future of the NHS**, supported by NHS England, to inform the Long Term plan of the NHS and was a member of the panel for the **Parliamentary Review of Health and Social Care in Wales 2018-19**. She is a member of the policy group overseeing the development of the **People Plan for the NHS & NHS Assembly** in England
